
ORDER

THE VILLAGE OF PINEHURST, JOHN STRICKLAND in his official capacity as Mayor of the Village of Pinehurst; and JANE HOGEMAN in her official capacity as a member of the Village of Pinehurst Council,
Defendants.

THIS CAUSE, coming on for hearing before the Honorable James M. Webb, Senior Resident Superior Court Judge, at the September 9, 2022 Civil Session of Superior Court for Moore County upon the Defendants' Verified Amended Motion to Dismiss, said Motion to Dismiss made pursuant to Rule 12 (b)(6) of the North Carolina Rules of Civil Procedure; and the Court, having considered the pleadings, the briefs filed by the parties and the arguments of the parties' respective counsel; and the Court concluding that the Complaint fails to state a claim upon which relief can be granted and that that the Motion to Dismiss should be ALLOWED, as all claims set forth in the Complaint are barred by the applicable 45-day statute of limitations set forth in N.C.G.S. 143-318.16A.;
